






























I am going to the audiology clinic today. They will check my hearing.

         
When I arrive, we go through the main hospital and down in the






My grown-up phones to tell the audiologist we are here.

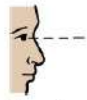
        
I can play with the toys while I wait for my turn.

       
The audiologist comes and says my name - it's my turn!

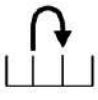
         
We go into the room and my grown-up answers some questions. I can
